Membership Scholarship

A qualified candidate must:

• Be a current graduate student (Masters or Doctoral) or in the first 1-5 years of their professional role at time of application submission

This scholarship is intended for grad students or new professionals who are unable to attend Annual Convention due to financial or other reasons. This scholarship will provide a year-long membership to ACPA where folks will be able to access ACPA2GO, the "Journal of College Student Development" and "About Campus", a network of Entity groups, and resources on the Strategic Imperative for Racial Justice and Decolonization.

A qualified candidate must:
